WHEREAS, the Village of Bradford has limited fiscal resources available for the procurement of heavy-duty construction equipment, vehicles, commodities, and other property; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois' Federal Surplus Property Program offers a variety of surplus property at approximately 5-25 percent of the acquisition value, effectively reducing program costs by acquiring items that have been used to their life expectancy or property that must be replaced for safety or economic reasons; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradford agrees to the following terms and conditions: to use the surplus property only in the official program which it represents; and upon receipt, agrees to place the surplus property into use within one year; and it agrees that the property shall be used for a period of one year (certain items, eighteen months); that it agrees it will not sell, loan, trade or tear down the property without written consent from the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradford understands that surplus property must be used in an authorized program and that personal use or non-use of surplus property is not allowed;

THEREFORE, WE THE ELECTED OFFICIALS of the Village of Bradford do hereby consent and decree that the Village of Bradford is authorized to participate in the State of Illinois Federal Surplus Property Program.

Section IV

The Village of Bradford has a population of 787 per the 2000 Census. The Village has two full-time employees, one as Maintenance Supervisor and one as Police Chief. The Village employs five part-time people in the areas of maintenance, clerical, and law enforcement. The Village also operates a public pool in the summer season and employs 6-8 people at the pool from June-August.

The Village of Bradford owns and operates a sewer treatment facility and water supply and treatment operations. The Village owns and maintains a Senior Citizens Center which provides a place for Senior meals and activities. The Village maintains the Village streets, sidewalks, parks, cemetery, public pool, recycling building, Village Hall, and Police Station.

Section V

The Village of Bradford receives money from the State of Illinois from Sales Tax, Income Tax, Personal Property Replacement Tax, Use Tax, Photoprocessing Tax, and Motor Fuel Tax. The Village receives money from Stark County from Real Estate Taxes. The Village residents pay a monthly rate for water and sewer service provided by the Village. The Village is beginning construction of a new Well. The Village received \$500,000 in CDAP Grant Funds to assist in the costs of the Well and will borrow \$97,000 for completion of the Well. In 2004, the Village completed construction of a \$1,000,000 Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant, mandated by the E.P.A. The Village received \$375,000 in CDAP Funds to assist in the costs of the R.O. Plant, in addition to a loan from the IEPA.
