#### **ORDINANCE NO. 15-16-33**

## Village of Bradford

Stark County, Illinois

### POSSESSION, SALE, OR USE OF FIREWORKS PROHIBITED

Whereas, the Village of Bradford has determined that the use of potentially dangerous explosive materials should be regulated for the public welfare.

Therefore, be it ordained, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradford, Stark County, Illinois, As Follows:

#### SECTION ONE.

- (1) It shall be unlawful or any person, firm, co-partnership, or corporation to knowingly possess, offer for sale, expose for sale, sell at retail, or use or explode any fireworks as defined in this ordinance within the village.
- (2) FIREWORKS. Any explosive composition, or any substance or combination of substances, or article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect of a temporary exhibitional nature by explosion, combustion, deflagration or detonation, and shall include blank cartridges, toy cannons, in which explosives are used, the type of balloons which require fire underneath to propel the same, firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, Roman candles, bombs or other fireworks of like construction and any fireworks containing any explosive compound or any tablets or other device containing any explosive substance, or containing combustible substances producing visual effects; provided, however, that the term FIREWORKS shall not include sparklers, toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns, or other devices in which paper or plastic caps containing .25 grains or less of explosive compound are used, providing they are so constructed that the hand cannot come in contact with the cap when in place for the explosion, and toy pistol paper or plastic caps which contain less than .25 grains of explosive mixture, the sale and use of which shall be permitted at all times.

**SECTION TWO.** All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or words thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or words have been declared invalid or unconstitutional,

and if for any reason this ordinance should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the remaining ordinance provisions will be in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on September 1st,

2016.
