

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HIRING STANDARDS FOR
PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS**

IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADFORD

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board of the Village of Bradford, Stark County, Illinois, are duly empowered by authority provided for Municipal Government in the Illinois Compiled Statutes to establish hiring standards for part-time police officers employed by the Village, such authority specifically authorized by 65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-21;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the President and Village Board of the Village of Bradford, Stark County, Illinois, as follows:

A. Employment. The Village of Bradford may employ part-time police officers from time to time as they deem necessary.

B. Duties. A part-time police officer shall have all the responsibilities of a full-time police officer and such specific duties as delineated in the General Orders of the Bradford Police Department, but the number of hours a part-time officer may work within a calendar year is restricted. Part-time police officers shall not be assigned to supervise or direct full-time police officers. Part-time police officers shall be trained in accordance with the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et. seq.) and the rules and requirements of the ILETSB.

C. Hiring Standards. Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:

1. Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE NUISANCE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradford has determined that the Village Nuisance Ordinance should be modified to expressly enumerate lack of water service to a occupied dwelling as an unsanitary condition and a Nuisance violation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADFORD, STARK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. That Title 7, Chapter 1 "Nuisances", Section 2-1 is amended by the addition thereto of sub-paragraph (Q) to read and shall be as follows:

Sec. 7-1-2-1: ENUMERATED:

(Q) To occupy as a dwelling any premises which lacks water service.

SECTION TWO. All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication as provided by law.
