#### ORDINANCE NO. 15 116-03

#### VILLAGE OF BRADFORD, STARK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

### AN ORDINANCE STANDARDIZING FINES AND ORDINANCE VIOLATION PROCEDURE

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradford determined that after committee discussion in regard to Ordinances and Ordinance Violations, that it is in the best interest of the Village to standardize the procedure and fines associated with Ordinance Violations, and

WHEREAS, there exists confusion in regard to Ordinance Violation police procedure for the Police.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADFORD, STARK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Police officers of the Village of Bradford are directed to provide citizens a warning with three (3) days to allow them time to resolve issues identified to be Ordinance Violations.
- 2. If after three (3) days, the issue has not been resolved, a ticket may be issued to the violator. Said ticket shall include the date on which the violator is to appear in Stark County Court to answer for the violation as well as the Ordinance Number allegedly violated.
- 3. The discretion as to whether to write the ticket may be exercised by the police officer in his best judgment, taking into account all reasonable factors.
- 4. The fine imposed for the offense is determined by the nature of the offense, past offenses, willingness to fix the problem, and shall be determined by the Village Attorney after weighing these factors subject to validation and discretion of the sitting Judge hearing the matter, but in any event shall not exceed \$500.00 for each occurrence. The fine shall not include costs which will be added to the fine imposed. These amounts are outside of the control of the Village, but are Stark County's costs of processing the violations.
