#### **ORDINANCE NO. 15-16-23**

### Village of Bradford

Stark County, Illinois

#### OBSTRUCTION OF DRIVER'S VIEW OR DRIVING MECHANISM

Whereas, the Village of Bradford has determined that vehicle operation should be regulated for the public safety.

Therefore, be it ordained, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradford, Stark County, Illinois, As Follows:

#### SECTION ONE.

- (A) No person shall drive a vehicle when it is so loaded, or when there are in the front seat such number of persons, exceeding three, or when there are animals transported in the vehicle in a manner which, so as to obstruct the view of the driver to the front or sides of the vehicle, or as to interfere with the driver's control over the driving mechanism of the vehicle.
- (B) No passenger in a vehicle or streetcar shall ride in a position as to interfere with the driver's or motorman's view ahead or to the sides, or to interfere with his control over the driving mechanism of the vehicle or streetcar.
- (C) No passenger on a school bus may ride or stand in a position as to interfere with the driver's view ahead or to the side or to the rear, or to interfere with his control of the driving mechanism of the bus.

**SECTION TWO**. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or words thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or words have been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if for any reason this ordinance should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the remaining ordinance provisions will be in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.
