AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE VILLAGE LIQUOR ORDINANCE


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradford has determined that the Liquor Ordinance should be modified to amend the hours that an establishment may sell alcoholic liquor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADFORD, STARK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

For any holder of a valid liquor license in which the license allows the authorization and retail sale of liquor on Sunday, the authorization is hereby amended and the license hereinafter allows the retail sale of alcoholic liquor to begin at 10:00 a.m. instead of 12:00 noon. This includes those establishments that has gaming, including slot machines.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form according to law.
