VILLAGE OF BRADFORD Stark County, Illinois

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY SNOW PARKING BAN IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADFORD, ILLINOIS, AND DECLARING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE IMMEDIATELY AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradford has determined that the Village shall implement a snow parking ban in emergencies;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADFORD, STARK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE.

No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on the streets of East Main and Silver Street when there is more than two (2) inches of snow and ice on the streets. This parking ban remains in effect until the snow has been removed or plowed from East Main and Silver Street and the snow has ceased to fall.

It shall be an Ordinance violation for any person to park on East Main and Silver Street when there is more than two (2) inches of snow and ice on the aforesaid streets. It shall be an additional ordinance violation for any day that the vehicle is not moved.

Violators will be towed.

SECTION TWO. All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication as provided by law.
